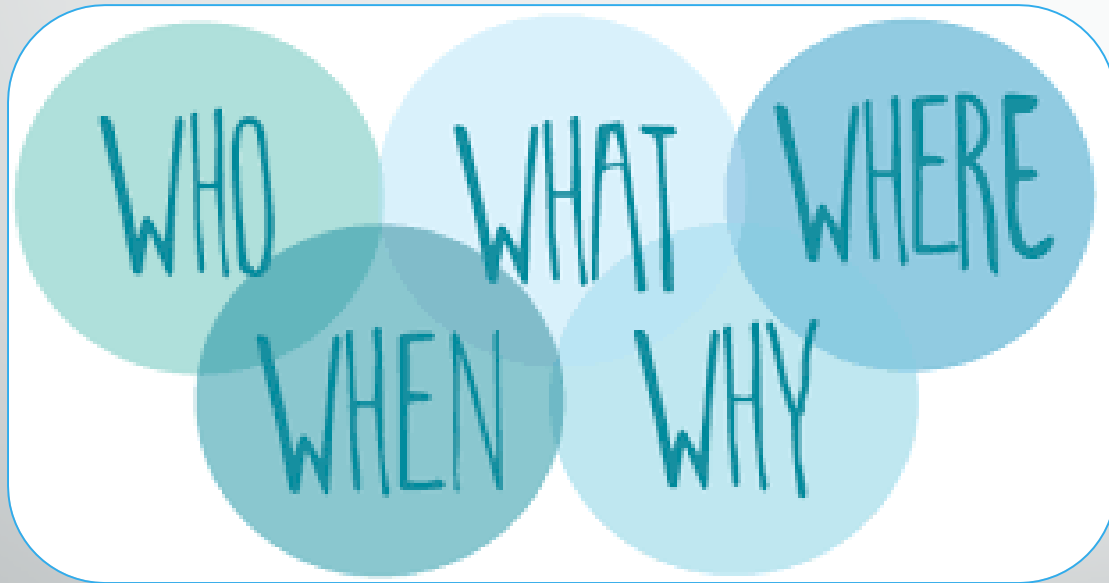

WHY are we doing this?

- Help meet EVD planning grant requirements

WHAT are we doing?

- Three-hour event at your hospitals:
 - 90-min training on HCID
 - 30-min transition
 - 60-min mystery patient drill



WHAT are we doing?

- Training format: PPT, handouts
- Content: key topics of concern, e.g.:
 - Intake – signs, symptoms, travel, etc.
 - Isolation & PPE
 - Waste mgmt & decon
 - Notifications & transfer



WHAT are we doing?

- Exercise format: simplified drill in which a mock pt presents in your ED
 - Intake process? Isolation process?
 - Notifications? Coordination?
 - PPE? Waste mgmt.?
- Real-world sensitivities will be addressed!



WHAT are we doing?

- As follow-up, you will receive a concise AAR highlighting strengths and areas for improvement



WHO is involved?

- CEMA: two-person team (tag-team instructors, then controller/evaluator & mock patient)
- Your staff: your choice (intake, ED, IPAC, HICS, etc.) – ideally 5-10 people at smaller facilities

WHERE will this happen?

- Training: ideally a training, meeting, conference, board, or similar room with table(s), chairs, A/V
- Drill: ideally in/near your ER, in an area where we will not compromise pt care or confidentiality

WHEN will this occur?

- Options of February 24 through April 10
- Must be wrapped by then to meet grant reqmt
